

Proverbs Series: #2 Listen
The Danger of Dissing Lady Wisdom

Proverbs 1:20-33



Application questions:

- Describe the two ways to live found in Proverbs: What is wisdom? What is folly? What are some of the characteristics of each?
- What is the relationship between character, conduct, and consequences? Describe both good and bad consequences that have followed from your character and conduct.
- CJ referenced Proverbs 13:20. Who are the “companions” in your life that influence you? What is the effect of this influence?
- How does Proverbs 1:22 reveal our need for a Savior? What is the “inside job” to which CJ referred?
- Ask someone close to you (spouse, roommate, parent) for an honest evaluation: “Am I easy to correct?” “Is there any way that I need correction right now?” “Are there ways that you’ve seen me grow in wisdom?”
